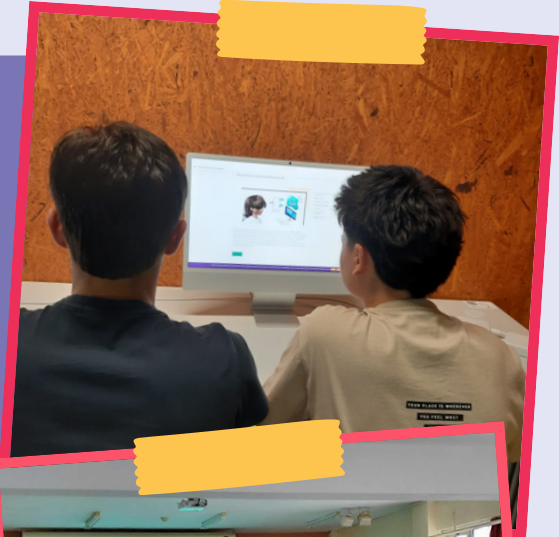
Piloting completed!
